

Distribution of Points/ Rank for shortlisting

Total Points: 200

1. Ranking of Institution 40% (80)

The points will be distributed according to the rank of institute notified by National Institutional Ranking Framework, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India.

Top 75 educational institutions in the categories of University (only University teaching Deptts shall be considered and colleges affiliated shall be ranked separately as per their ranking in NIRF), Colleges, Management institutes, and Law institutes under NIRF 2020, will be considered for the purpose of allocating the points. The points will be given as per enclosed annexures.

Rest of the educational institutions, not falling under these four categories will not be considered for points and graded 0.

2. Academic Performance 20% (40)

Applicant with 100% mark (after grade-point conversion) will be given 40 points. All the others will be marked as below:

3. Volunteering/Work experience in NSS/NCC/NGO 40% (80)

The maximum points for experience of the applicant in NSS or NCC or NGO will be upto 80 and certificate for the same is required to be uploaded at the time of applying online. The applicant will be eligible to claim the points either in NSS or NCC or NGO and not all the three. The points will be considered as:

3.1. National Service Scheme (NSS)

The points for the NSS will be considered in the following manner:

- 240 hours in regular activities in 2 years, seven days rural camp and participation in national level programme/event: 80 points.
- 240 hours in regular activities in 2 years, seven days rural camp and participation in state level programme/event: 70 points.
- 240 hours in regular activities in 2 years, seven days rural camp and participation in district level programme/event: 60 points.
- 240 hours in regular activities in 2 years and seven days rural camp: 50 points

3.2. National Cadet Corps (NCC)

The points for the NCC will be considered as:

- Certificate-C and participation in national/state level event: 80 points
- Certificate-B and participation in national/state level event or Certificate-C: 70 points.
- Certificate-A and participation in national/state level event or Certificate-B: 60 points
- Certificate-A: 50 points

3.3. Non-Governmental Organization (NGO)

The points for the duration of work experience/volunteerism in any reputed NGO will be admissible as:

- One year and above: 80 points.
- Six months to one year: 70 points.

Internship is NOT considered as work experience
