ADMISSION NOTICE

(Three Month Certificate Course on Geriatric Care for Bedside Assistance/Caregivers)

This training involves imparting knowledge and understanding of ageing, the age-related diseases and disabilities suffered by elders, their needs and behaviour. It equips the trainees with necessary basic skills to handle and manage the ailing elders and keep them comfortable as expected by the family members and directed by the doctors attending on them either at their homes or in institutions.

It includes two months classroom training along with orientation visits, external expert's classes and one month on job training (OJT) at reputed hospitals. The course is non- residential from 10.00 am to 4.00 pm on working days. The institute is not providing any boarding & lodging facilities for the training.

Applications are invited for the admission to "Three Month Certificate Course on Geriatric Care for Bedside Assistance/Caregivers" at New Delhi, is being offered by National Institute of Social Defence (NISD) at New Delhi during financial year 2023- 24.

Eligibility Criteria:

a) Educational Qualification:

Essential: Minimum Educational Qualification is 10th pass.

Desirable: Preference will be given to the candidates having certificates / experience(s)/training of working in (Home setting, Hospital, Age Care Institutions, Nursing home, NGOs)

b) Age Limit: Minimum 18years (in completed years as on date of advertisement), Max: 40yrs & physically & mentally fit.

c) No. of seats: 25 seats (max)

d) Course fees: Nil (Free)

e) Selection Criterion: The suitable candidates should be selected through personal interviews.

The final selections are based on the interest to work for the care of senior citizens, qualification, age criteria, valid aadhaar card & verifications of original documents.

The filled up application form along with documents (photocopy of educational qualification, age proof & Aadhaar card etc.), addressed to "The Deputy Director, Senior Citizen Division, should reach on or before last date of receiving applications.
