- The program for GIA functionaries can be conducted subject to their availability by the implementing agencies.
- Training programs/courses and participants number is an estimated number and may increase or decrease depending on the availability of suitable proposals.
- Re-appropriation of budget and program numbers is permissible among different categories of programs for effective implementation of programs.
- Any other training program/event (not covered above) and found deemed fit with the approval of Director NISD.
